



SERMON OF HIS HOLINESS POPE PETER III IN GERMANY, 7TH OF JUNE 2026

We, Pope Peter III, would once again like to thank everyone for the necessary help for the Holy Mother Church.

Unfortunately, We had very little time to prepare a sermon. But We do wish to preach something to the faithful. Some advice for parents with children. Marriage should be a continuation of the engagement period. Before marriage, everything seemed to be roses. After marriage, there are many roses, but also many thorns. Why? What mistakes does one make in marriage? What solutions are there? Here is some advice. Palmarian families should always imitate the Holy Family, Jesus, Mary and Joseph. They were a great and holy example. They were always together. They lived together in holiness. They never quarrelled. They always set a good example, such that many were converted through their examples. Through the presence of the Holy Family in Egypt, the idols fell with a loud crash, their temples collapsed and the altars for idol worship were destroyed before the eyes of the frightened inhabitants, for the Child Jesus drove away the devils through His divine power and cast them out, and these fell like lightning into the hidden depths of hell. In the face of these events and other miracles, the frightened inhabitants drew near to the Holy Family, who drew them towards the truth through their conversations and miracles, whereby many turned to the Lord and God of Hosts and did penance. After the return of the Holy Family to Israel, many of the converted Egyptians venerated the house in which such exalted visitors had lived as a holy temple and gathered there to pray. Palmarian marriages can also work miracles with their good example, saving many souls. When the diabolical television did not yet exist, the whole family prayed the Rosary together. Since

the diabolical television took the place of honour in the homes of non-Palmarians, there is no longer any time for the Rosary. And when the Rosary is not prayed, the Holy Family cannot bless the home. This is why there are so many quarrels, infidelity and divorces. All Palmarians must pray the Holy Penitential Rosary, but many do not do so correctly. There are families who do not pray the Holy Penitential Rosary together. Each in their own way. This is not correct and is very dangerous. Both parents, father and mother, should pray together, and if they have children, all together. The Holy Family was united, and the same should be true of a Palmarian family. Parents must ensure that their children pray everything and pray well. If the father of the family works all day and returns late in the evening, it is the mother who should pray with the children. The father of the family should do so at the weekend. But if the father of the family has the opportunity to pray with the whole family, then he has the duty to do so. It is very sad and heartbreaking to know that there are many, many marriage separations among non-Palmarians. Why? Because they do not pray. Just a few examples: Belgium approximately 71%, Spain approximately 47%, North America approximately 50%, Switzerland approximately 40%. This is very bad; the children, if they have any, suffer greatly as a result. The percentage of marriage separations among non-Palmarian families who pray the Rosary every day is only 1%. The solution lies in praying together every day. Separation is merely an expression of distress in marriages. Further hardships such as quarrels, hatred, violence, addictions of all kinds, manipulation, illness, unemployment, debt, and even traumatic experiences burden marriages and families. Therefore, marriages and families need a great deal of prayer. What a blessing it is to pray together! The devil does not like it when married couples pray together. He therefore tries his utmost to prevent this from happening. A famous quote captures the significance perfectly: “The family that prays together, stays together!” In the hectic routine of daily life, the family Rosary can become a moment of rest and reflection. It reminds us that together, as a family, we can form a strong unit. Padre Pio of Pietrelcina described the Rosary as his “greatest weapon” in spiritual life – a source of strength that helps us not to lose courage in difficult times. The Rosary is not merely a prayer, but a tool that helps us to face life's challenges with serenity and confidence, and to resist spiritual attacks and temptations. When we pray the Rosary together, we strengthen not only our relationship with God and Our Lady, but also the bonds within our family. It is a powerful step towards entrusting ourselves as a family to the Queen of the Rosary and strengthening our spiritual connection. By practising the Rosary prayer, we nurture a tradition that has given countless families a firm foundation in faith. Thus, the Rosary is not only a prayer for the protection and strengthening of our loved ones, but also a wonderful way to remain united as a family in faith.

In Our last Apostolic Letter, the devil was compelled against his will to speak the truth. This letter is a good confirmation that the Palmarian Church is the True Church, because the True Church fights against satanic modernism. The Second

In this situation... in these times, we now live. The devil also had to speak of some important books, against his will. The books of Saint Anne Catherine Emmerich and Mother Mary of Jesus of Ágreda. A great deal of their books can now be found in the Palmarian Bible and in the Treatise of the Holy Mass. Also the book of Saint Thomas à Kempis, the Imitation of Christ. Likewise the book of Saint Louis Mary Grignion of Montfort, the True Devotion to the Most Blessed Virgin Mary. You also have the book, the Greatness of the Most Holy Virgin Mary. All these books which Hell hates, you possess. They were given to the faithful before We knew of this exorcism. Everyone should have these books. These books should be absent from no Catholic family. Through these books, people would be prompted to walk on better paths. In these books they will learn how the Most Blessed Virgin lived and how much She suffered. In order to know the eternal plans of God, insofar as people can know these plans, they will find credible and reliable sources of faith therein. In them the faithful will find the foundation for everything. You must not neglect to read these books. The priests should proclaim it to all creatures. I must repeat it. It is necessary to proclaim it from the pulpit. She who is up above wishes that these books become known to the four corners of the earth. These books should be bound to the backs of children, so that they learn to walk with the cross that the Lord has placed on their path. But it is also necessary to seek in these books topics for sermons, ideas for the presently confused world, for the faithful of our time. The devil, against his will, had to say this. He had to say that all priests should preach this. Now it is the Pope in person who preaches this out loud. You have the sacred duty to read something spiritual every day. You waste a great deal of time with mobile phones and other worldly things and have no time to read something spiritual. That is a sin of omission. And the parents who know this commit the same sin. Parents have the sacred duty to help ensure that both they themselves and their children read something spiritual every day. And what they read must remain in the mind. How will you be able to persevere, how will you be able to overcome daily temptations, if you know nothing at all? How will you be able to improve in your spiritual life? We are not saying that everyone has to become a religious brother or sister, no. What We are saying is that all of you must sanctify your state in life, whether as married, single, or religious. We, Pope Peter III, repeat it once more with a mighty voice, you have the sacred duty to read something spiritual every day for the good of your souls.
