



SERMON OF HIS HOLINESS POPE PETER III IN IRELAND, 13TH OF SEPTEMBER 2026

Ave María Purísima!

We, Pope Peter III, once more wish to show Our gratitude to all for the very necessary help you give to Holy Mother Church.

Today we wish to preach on a matter which is worrying us deeply. Prayer well said.

Why do you pray every day obligatorily the Holy Penitential Rosary, the Holy Way of the Cross or the Holy Gregorian Way of the Cross and the Act of Consecration to the Holy Face of Our Lord Jesus Christ? Prayer is the nourishment our soul needs to persevere. Without prayer, the soul dies. Every day we have to eat and drink to nourish our bodies. The soul too needs its nourishment, which is prayer. But to fulfil our obligation to pray, prayer has to be well done.

To gain the 50 Plenary Indulgences of the Holy Penitential Rosary and the 15 Plenary Indulgences for the Holy Way of the Cross or Holy Gregorian Way of the Cross, there are conditions, as stated in the Palmarian Catechism. Whenever the 50 beads are prayed on the same day and you pray for the Pope's intentions. Whenever the 15 Stations are prayed on the same day and you pray for the Pope's intentions.

Now Our great worry, that many faithful do not fulfil these obligations. Why not? For not praying the 50 beads of the Holy Penitential Rosary. For not praying the 15 stations of the Holy Way of the Cross or Holy Gregorian

Way of the Cross. We observe, deeply saddened, that many pray distracted, and speak many other things or do not pray, or leave the Chapel, rush here and there, and never recover the prayers omitted. And the worst is that for not complying well with the obligatory prayers, they fall into mortal sin.

Who confesses not having recited the obligatory prayers in their entirety? Not one!

Beloved parents, help your children with the obligatory prayers every day. This is not to provoke scruples, no; We are the first to struggle against this grave spiritual affliction. You have to be sure that all the members of the family have prayed all the obligatory prayers, whether grown-up or little. It is easy to pray with another, or others, harder to pray alone.

One important detail: The Bishops and Nuns who have spent several years outside the Church in apostasy, have had the grace to return to the Holy Order of the Crossbearers of the Last Times thanks to having prayed the Holy Penitential Rosary and other prayers when they were outside.

Let us remember the Messages on the Penitential Rosary, like this one from the Eternal Father in 1974:

“The infernal enemy unleashes fierce attacks against this Rosary. For Satan cannot now cry out to this God and Lord, as you can, with that lovely phrase of ‘Our Father’. Every time you recite the Our Father devoutly, Satan feels convulsed; and in the very depths of Hell, he lashes out proudly against his Creator. So then, My dear children, recite the Our Father constantly, and you will see that Satan keeps well away from you. Try meditating lovingly, slowly, on the Our Father, and you will see how delightful it is to the senses of the soul, soul which has been created by this Father of yours...

“O dear children! Relish the prayer of the Our Father. Relish it! And you will find delight in prayer...

“How can I fail to hear My children who continually say: Father! Father! Father! Father! What father does not listen to his children? How much more so this Father who created you!

“Hence, My dear children, cry out continually to this Father of yours! ‘I need many Our Fathers, many Our Fathers, so that there be reparation for the infinite offences I constantly receive. And be sure that this Father will be swift to listen to all His children.’”

The Eternal Father asks for more Penitential Rosaries, and continues:

“This will mean greater sacrifice for yourselves; but if you do not perform this sacrifice... who will? Tell Me yourselves: who shall be able to defend this Penitential Rosary? Only yourselves, who are the living beacon of this Place; with your defects, your mistakes, your weaknesses, but the Beacon.

And this Beacon of El Palmar de Troya is the Light of the world in these times of confusion, error and darkness. And I ask you, beloved little children, are you going to refuse another Penitential Rosary to your Father who has granted you this Place as Light and Cathedra for these Last Times? There you have the means of giving thanks to your Father. I ask no more of you. And you will see that, from this Penitential Rosary which you are going to add to the prayers of El Palmar de Troya, great blessings will come upon the Church and upon the world..."

Beloved children: When a father loves his children in holiness, he does not allow them to do all that they like or spend all their time in games and amusements, or in bad company, since he knows that this will be their ruin. If he loves his children, he requires them to practise the Christian virtues, love God and Most Holy Mary, and to study and work so as not to live in misery either in this life or in eternity. If he does not do this, those same children will recriminate him on the Day of Judgement for not having obliged them with his authority as father.

Likewise, We, as Father and Pastor of your souls, cannot be indifferent on seeing that some faithful make little effort to love and serve God, and become so much weaker that they will fall when difficulties and trials come upon them. We feel great concern for weak faithful, as We fear that any faithful who does not live a true spiritual life "will be like an imprudent man who built his house upon sand. And then when rain fell and rivers overflowed and winds blew strongly against that house, it fell down and great was its ruin," as the Holy Gospel says.

The Penitential Rosary is to atone to God and to His Most Holy Mother for the many offences they receive daily from blasphemers, heretics and the ungodly.

In His Message of the 5th of September 1974, the Eternal Father said:

"Look, My children: in these Last Times, when the Holy Sacrifice has been practically abolished by the confection of the new mass which is merely a banquet, I need many Our Fathers, many Our Fathers, so that there be reparation for the infinite offences I constantly receive..."

Now, surely enough, the Holy Sacrifice of the Altar has been re-established in the Holy Palmarian Church, but only a few Priests remain, and so there are few Masses, owing to the lack of vocations, or lack of response to vocations. Hence today, more than ever, God needs many Our Fathers, many Penitential Rosaries, to make reparation for the sins of an utterly corrupt world. Continuously, daily, sinners are dying, and need help, need the prayers of Palmarians in order to save themselves eternally.

The Messages say: *“O unhappy mankind! Where are you off to? The reply is obvious: to the precipice, to self-destruction. Hence, My dear children, cry out continually to this Father of yours!”*

“Pray every day for those who are in agony. Pray, pray. At the moment of agony is when God appears with all His graces. But it is also the moment when Satan appears with all his infernal forces.”

Let us bear very much in mind those souls who, at that supreme moment, depend on our generosity in praying the Holy Penitential Rosary; they will be grateful to us in Heaven. Moreover, with the Penitential Rosary we give thanks to God and to our Heavenly Mother for the infinite mercies we receive every day from Their goodness, and thus we shall grow in Their love.
